

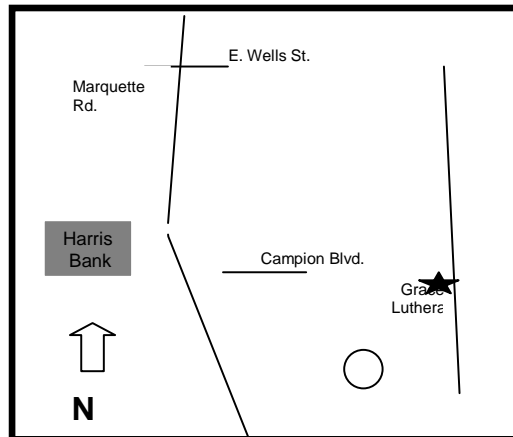
# Class Sessions

Preschool: Monday-Thurs. 8:15-11:15 a.m.  
(Pick and Choose Your Days!)  
Extended Care: Follows Preschool-4p.m.

- Children must be at least 3 years old before joining the class (can join after the school year has started).
- Sessions begin after Labor Day.
- Preschool Tuition Cost:
  - 1-day- \$35/month
  - 2-days- \$70/month
  - 3-days- \$95/month
  - 4-days-\$140/month
- Extended Care: \$3.00/hour
